DECISION OF THE MINISTERIAL APPEALS COMMITTEE ON DDT COLLEGE OF MEDICINE

Botswana Qualifications Authority (BQA) wishes to inform the public, learners, parents, employers, and stakeholders of the status regarding **DDT College**.

Following BQA's regulatory decision to revoke DDT College's registration and accreditation status due to non-compliances with accreditation requirements, **DDT College** appealed the decision in accordance with the provisions of the BQA Act. The Ministerial Appeals Committee has considered the matter.

The Ministerial Appeals Committee has granted **DDT College** a period of six (6) months to address and close the identified non-compliances. In the meantime, DDT College shall continue offering learning services.

Therefore:

- DDT College is required to implement corrective actions within the next six (6) months.
- The institution will be **monitored and assessed** for compliance during and after this period; and
- Any further regulatory action will be determined **upon completion of the stipulated timeframe**, in line with the law and applicable procedures.

BQA will continue to discharge its statutory mandate to safeguard the quality and integrity of education and training in Botswana, while ensuring due process and learner protection.
