RATIONALE AND PURPOSE OF THE QUALIFICATION

Rationale

The certificate qualification in general agriculture and animal health were designed to provide a wide spectrum of skills and knowledge in agriculture and basic sciences to prepare the graduates to function as extension generalist in the planning and implementation of agriculture extension programs at the now Ministry of Agriculture Development and Food Security. The expansion of the extension system at all levels called for increased training to prepare Frontline Extension Workers to cope with new and changing responsibilities in the modern-day extension management and supervision (Ministry of Finance and Development Planning, 2003). The recently introduced Government schemes such as ISPAAD and LIMID, with challenging responsibilities that require upgrading of technical competencies of staff at all levels. The rapidly changing social and natural environment in Botswana; the irreversible technological changes in agriculture; the devastating effects of HIV/AIDS on agricultural production, agricultural workforce and rural communities and the unpredictable climate conditions in Botswana need highly trained workforce in agricultural extension to face the new challenges in Botswana's endeavour to meet the national food security needs (National Extension Conference, 1995; UNAIDS, 2002; and Ministry of Finance and Development Planning, 2016).

Purpose

The purpose of this qualification is to produce graduates with advanced knowledge, skills and competences to:

- Identify and close gaps in Botswana's Agricultural Extension system.
- Demonstrate an understanding on the nature of agricultural extension, principles and practices and its role in agricultural development.
- Apply skills for agricultural technology dissemination and adoption.

QUALIFICATION AWARD AND CERTIFICATION

Qualification Award

Graduates will be awarded Diploma in Agricultural Extension on attaining a minimum of 240 credits and meet all the rules of combination.

Certification

There will be issuance of Certificate and transcript at award.

REGIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL COMPARABILITY

The proposed qualification is largely similar to the examined qualifications in terms of course content and qualification purpose. Nonetheless there were some relatively minor dissimilarities noted. The examined qualifications are SAQA National Diploma in Agricultural Extension; University of Nigeria Diploma in Agricultural Extension; Egerton University Diploma in Agricultural Education and Extension.

Areas of similarities in terms of course content:

The SAQA qualification offers the following modules which are similar to those in the proposed qualification:

- Extension principles and extension teaching methods
- Communication in extension
- Data analysis and computing
- Extension organization management
- Agricultural extension philosophy
- Rural social systems

In addition, the purpose of the proposed qualification compares favourably with those of the examined qualifications. For example, the purpose of the proposed qualification is to:

- Fill identified gaps in Botswana's agricultural system
- Provide learners with broad understanding on the nature of agricultural extension, principles and practices
- Equip graduates with skills for agricultural technology dissemination and adoption
- Supply continuously updated information that farmers and people in agriculture related industries require to increase food production and quality of life.

In comparison, the purpose of the SAQA qualification is to:

- Apply integrated knowledge, skills and values of the principles and philosophy of extension in an intervention
- Design a farm plan based on natural resources for the development and implementation of a sound production strategy to ensure sustainable resource utilization

The purpose of the Egerton University qualification which is equally similar to the purpose of the proposed qualification is to:

- Produce individuals who have undergone training in technical agriculture, extension education, agricultural education and communication skills to meet the demands of modern agriculture
- Acquire skills of setting up and managing agribusiness

Areas of dissimilarities

The proposed qualification and the University of Nigeria qualification offer the following modules which are not offered by Egerton University:

- Extension administration and supervision
- Community organizations and local leadership
- Rural extension youth programs

In the same vein the University of Nigeria qualification has the following modules not offered by the proposed qualification and University of Egerton qualification:

- Psychology in extension
- Advanced rural sociology

The SAQA qualification offers the following modules not offered in the proposed qualification and University of Nigeria qualification:

- Community analysis
- Current issues in rural development

Duration

- The proposed qualification is to run for two (2) years
- The Egerton University qualification runs for three (3) years
- The SAQA qualification runs for one (1) year
- The University of Nigeria qualification runs for two (2) years
- In addition, the Egerton University qualification has significant agricultural education component while the other three do not.
